- ♠ In 2000, JACET Vocabulary List Revising Committee (chair: Dr. Minoru Murata) was established. This committee aimed to revise JACET 4000 (1981), the original list of 4000 words.
- In 2003, the committee published The JACET List of 8000 Basic Words and also in 2004, The Handbook of JACET8000 Usage was published.

Foundation ~2~

- The committee fulfilled its original purpose and was disbanded in 2004.
- Not only to keep up with but also to lead the vocabulary acquisition research in Japan, a Special Interest Group: Vocabulary Acquisition Research Group (VARG) was established.
- VARG has been a rapport between users and the JACET headquarter.

Foundation ~3~

- With the leadership of the first executive members, Dr. K. Aizawa and Dr. M. Mochizuki, VARG started to hold book reading sessions and annual conferences regularly.
- There are currently 24 active members in the VARG, and aside from the official members, there are many teachers and researchers regularly participating our events.
